WEBSITE POLICY

The aim of the Hart Parish Council Website is to provide a vehicle for the provision of information and communication from the Parish Council and other appropriate village organisations to residents of the village and beyond.

Information on the website will relate to general Parish Council business such as minutes, agendas, finances etc., public notices and details of activities and information from any club, organisation or other body in the Village which is approved by the Parish Council and is on a not-for-profit or charitable basis.

The Parish Council has ultimate responsibility for the Website; the Clerk will normally act as Webmaster and oversee the site and be responsible for its day to day running.

The Parish Council has ultimate decision making over content and is the sole arbiter of what information will or will not be included in the website.

Paid for advertising and notices of a commercial nature will not be carried on the website.

The website will publish factual information and will not normally publish opinions unless they relate to Parish Council business.

The Web site will comply with Data Protection Legislation.

The website will comply with all Parish Council policies generally and in particular the Safeguarding Policy in relation to children and vulnerable adults.

In the event that an objection to the content of the site is received, the Webmaster will seek guidance from the Parish Councillor appointed to provide support on webpage issues, as to whether the content should be removed immediately or considered at the next meeting of the Parish Council.
